The following activities are scheduled for March 2nd through March 6th from 6:30am to 4:00pm each day.

- Mass excavation at south area of site and export of 1,500 tons of soil per day.
- Gravel work surface and sub-grade prep at south areas of garage and bldg “B”.
- Shoring and tie-backs at building “B”.
- Structural excavation at bldg “B” level P1.
- Spread and mat footing forms at building “B”, level P1.
- Underground electrical Ductbank installation and trenching south at building “B”.
- Column and wall forming at the Garage area, level P2- P1.
- Vertical formwork at building “A”, columns and shear walls, P1 – level 1.
- Shotcrete at perimeter walls, NW corner of building “A”.
- Spread footing and perimeter wall footing construction at building “A” and north Garage.
- Capillary break placement for building “A” slab on grade.
- Gravel and material deliveries will be occurring during the week as well. Access will be through Gate “A”, “B” and “F”, exiting through Gates “D”, “B”, “E” and “F”.
- Underground plumbing rough in at P2 level of garage.
- Demo of existing King County Metro manhole at Republican and 6th Ave. N. continues.
- Vertical waterproofing system on lagging at the north side of building “A” and NE corner of garage.

Neighborhood Impacts:

- 80-150 trucks and trailers entering and exiting the jobsite each day, up to 80 round trips exporting soil. There will be flaggers and a police officer to assist with traffic control at Gates B, D & F.
- Dump trucks are entering Gate “B” (North) and exiting Gate “D” (Southeast), entering Gate “E” (southeast) exiting out Gate “F”. Access in and out from Broad Street, Harrison Street, 5th Avenue North and Mercer Street.
- Concrete, gravel and other deliveries may arrive through gate “A” as well.
