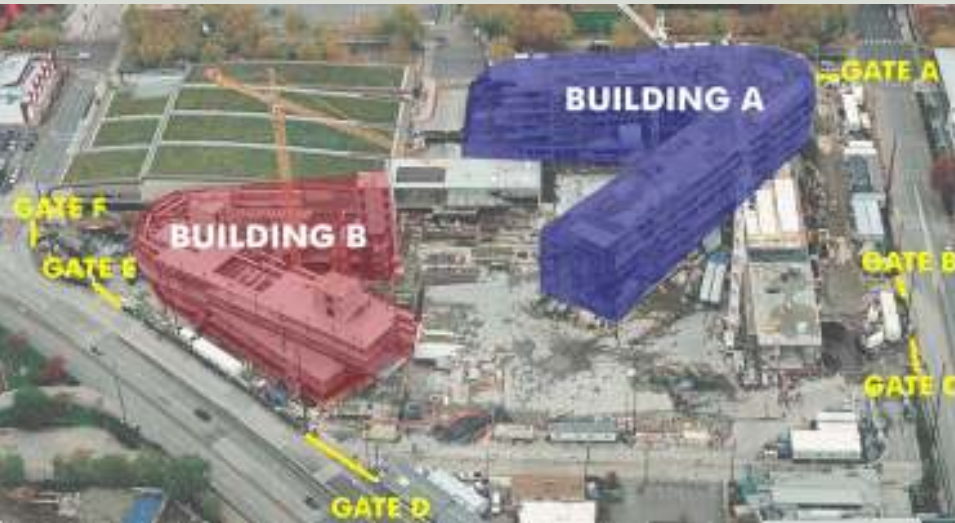

**The following activities are scheduled for April 26<sup>th</sup> through May 10<sup>th</sup> from 7:00am to 5:30pm each week day, and 9:00am to 6:00pm Saturday.**

- Tower crane removal at Bldg “A;” May 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup>. Curtain wall installation at Building “B”, level 3-5.
- Roofing membrane and mechanical equipment installation at building “B”, roof ballast, pavers and topsoil at Building “A” roofs.
- Cable net glass system installing at Building “A” atrium exterior.
- Framing and drywall activities at all levels of Building “A” interior P1, 1 and 2 of Building “B”.
- Raised flooring installation at levels 1 of Bldg “A” interior.
- Reception building exterior framing and glass installation.
- Exterior stone and metal siding at building “A”, exterior metal siding at Bldg “B”.
- Construction of Thermal Energy Storage tank continues south of Building “B”, excavation completes.
- Entry Court and Campus Heart planter walls, paver slabs, Hydrotech and mortar pavers continue.
- Deep utilities at North Road, electrical duct bank and storm line installation continue.
- SDOT frontage work at 5<sup>th</sup> Avenue North and Broad Street off ramp.

### Neighborhood Impacts:

- SDOT Frontage improvements work will Continue along 5<sup>th</sup> Ave N from Republican to Mercer. Watch for sidewalk closures and pedestrian detours to the west side of 5<sup>th</sup> Ave N. The Metro bus stop has been removed and the east northbound right turn lane will be partially closed 24/7 for curb, sidewalk and utility improvement work. Watch for intermittent closures of the north entrance to Seattle Center Garage.
- Broad Street off ramp/Seattle Center exit from Hwy 99 will be closed from 4/19 to 7/2 for utility work and perimeter wall pilings.
- Continued truck traffic, deliveries and export from gates A, C, D and F. Watch for flaggers and signage on 5<sup>th</sup> Ave, Mercer and Broad St.
