Project Update BELLEVUE 600 | NOVEMBER 2023

ACTIVITY

In November, the following work will be in-progress at the Bellevue 600 project:

- **Saturday, November 4:** The road will be closed on 10th Avenue NE from NE 6th Street to mid-block of 108th Avenue NE between the hours of 5:00 a.m. and 6:00 p.m. for hoisting of equipment needed to complete the mass excavation work.
- Saturday, Nov. 18 Sunday, Nov. 19: 108th Ave NE will be closed between NE 6th St. and mid-block of 108th Ave NE for the erection of a tower crane. This closure will begin at 4:30 a.m. on November 18 and reopen by 7 p.m. on November 19.
- Traffic along 108th Ave. NE will increase in November as structural excavation work begins.
- Pedestrians are being rerouted due to sidewalk closures adjacent to the site on 108th Avenue NE, 110th Avenue NE and NE 6th Street. Please refer to the map for more details.
- Underground street improvements on 108th Avenue NE and 110th Avenue NE will continue this month.
- To facilitate construction activities on the project, the team will be shifting traffic on 110th Avenue NE. Southbound traffic control measures will be in place Monday through Friday.
- Mass excavation work on Phase 2 will continue in November. Traffic along 108th Ave. NE will increase as this activity progresses.
- The City of Bellevue started construction in mid-May at the intersections of 110th Avenue NE and NE 6th Street and 108th Avenue NE and NE 6th Street. While this activity may impact traffic flow around the job site, it is not related to Sellen's ongoing work on the Bellevue 600 project. Updates related to the work in these two intersections will be communicated by the City of Bellevue.
