CONSTRUCTION UPDATE | FEB 2023

ABOUT THE PROJECT

We're excited to announce that the Seattle Storm Center for Basketball Performance will start construction soon. The design includes strength and fitness spaces specifically designed for the professional WNBA players; two side-by-side basketball courts; and two exterior 3x half courts to accommodate the fast growing 3x3 game that debuted in the 2020 Olympics. This is the first time the front office staff and players will occupy the same building. Construction is expected to begin in Spring 2023 and be completed in time to accommodate the start of the 2024 WNBA season. **Updates will be distributed on a monthly basis and as needed to communicate upcoming activities and any associated impacts to surrounding streets and sidewalks.**

UPCOMING CONSTRUCTION ACTIVITY

- **Starting February 20:** Sellen crews will begin mobilizing efforts on site, resulting in increased construction equipment traffic and added personnel parking on site.
- **Starting February 21:** 16th Avenue West will be reduced to one lane between West Bertona and Thorndyke Avenue West. Flaggers will be in place to help direct traffic. Please refer to the attached map for more information.
- **Upcoming Closure March 6-10:** Thorndyke Avenue West between 16th Avenue West and West Bertona will be closed one week for water and sewer tie-in activities. Traffic control measures will be in place to reroute vehicle traffic.
